HISTORY

The Great Fire of London

We will be exploring all aspects of The Great Fire of London. We will use books and the internet to research how the fire started and why it spread so quickly. From this we be able to compare the differences between 1666 and 2019 and what we could do nowadays to prevent or stop a fire.

We will also be Travelling back in the Oak Class Tardis, reaching our destination of London, 1666. The children will participate in a 'Stuart Day', where we will dress, learn and eat like Stuart people.

MATHEMATICS

Partitioning

We will be continuing with partitioning, looking at number bonds and writing number sentences. The children will be using larger numbers and recording their findings.

Money

We will be learning about money. The children will be looking at different coin values and considering which coins need to be used to find an overall total.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

Building Blocks

We will be participating in a Building Block Workshop at the Weald and Downland Museum. The children will be exploring different materials and how they can be used to build houses.

Stuart Houses

The children will be designing and building their own cardboard Stuart houses. We will then set up a miniature 'Pudding Lane' and investigate how quickly a real fire spreads.
