Dear Parents/ Carers,

We have planned for a full re-opening in September following Government guidelines. This involves risk assessing the use of the whole site and how we work with our parents and children. We have some time changes that will affect your drop off routines and picking up times. However we

have kept them as close as possible to our usual routines.

Staggered Drop Off Times:

Years 4,5,6. 8.30- 8.40 a.m.	Drop these children at the end of the path and they walk straight to their classroom.
Years 1,2,3. 8.40- 8.50 a.m.	Parents to walk to field to drop off- this will be reviewed after first full week back.
Rainbows walk to their classroom through playground according to their timetable. You will be met at the gate.	Parents with children for first few visits.

If you have children in both groups please wait in the seated quiet area with younger children until 8.40 to take them around. Children will not be able to go on the trimtrail or play with equipment before school as most school staff will be in class.

Pick-up Times:

Years 4,5,6. <b>3.05 p.m.</b>	Children will be brought out to front of building

Years 1,2,3. <b>3.15 p.m.</b>	On playground as normal.
