



ENGLISH

SCIENCE

While exploring our planet (and our school environment) we will be considering the variations between all living things and considering why animals and plants live in different places.



We will be asking questions and finding answers by setting up experiments in the school Bee Garden and observing what happens over the course of the year.

GEOGRAPHY

This half term we will be looking at the key human and physical features found in our country. We will be using aerial photographs to help us identify these and creating our own maps which pinpoint these features using a key.



We will also learning to name the 7 continents and 5 oceans that can be seen from space!

FOOD TECHNOLOGY

We will be designing, making and evaluating a food product made from tomatoes in our garden to show aliens how we prepare and use our plants to keep us healthy.



MATHEMATICS

We will be focusing this half



term on PLACE VALUE. We will be exploring what the digits mean in numbers and representing these in lots of different ways using a wide range of equipment. We will then use this understanding to help us with our calculations and to solve problems.

We will be focusing on one more and one less.

We will count in 10s to 50. Identify and represent numbers using objects, mathematical manipulatives and pictorial representations.

Use the language of one more than 6 is 7; one less that 7 is 6
