**School Admissions 2021 – 2022**

Due to the Covid pandemic, all appeals will be held based upon written submission. This is in line with the DfE's School Admissions (England) (Coronavirus) (Appeals Arrangements) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

For **community** and **voluntary** controlled schools (i.e. schools for which Hampshire County Council is the admission authority) appeals will follow the timetable below:

*For infant, junior and all-through primary schools which are their own admission authority (i.e. Academy, Foundation, Trust and Voluntary Aided schools), please refer to the individual school for their appeal dates.*

National Notification date for on-time applications.	Friday 16 <sup>th</sup> April 2021.
Notification date for late applicants ( <i>whose applications received after 15 January and before the 16 April 2021</i> )	Monday 26 <sup>th</sup> April 2021.
Deadline date for parents wishing to lodge an appeal. ( <i>Returning completed appeal papers to the school.</i> )	Monday 17 <sup>th</sup> May 2021.
Appeal hearing to be held.	From 7 <sup>th</sup> June to 16 <sup>th</sup> July, inclusive

**Please note**

- (i) Appeals lodged after 17 May 2021 will be heard during the above dates if possible, or within 42 calendar days (excluding any school holidays) of the appeal being lodged. Appeals lodged on or after 15 June 2021 may not be heard until the autumn term.
- (ii) Following the lodging of an appeal, additional papers may be submitted to the Appeals Service until 23 calendar days before the hearing. Evidence admitted after this date will be considered by the panel, but this may lead to an adjournment and significant delays.

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
