WELL-BEING QUESTIONNAIRE UPDATE

In response to the recent school survey you kindly completed, we have a few updates for you.

Question 1: Who is responsible for mental health and well-being?

The answer to this is all the staff. We train all staff to help, support and teach in this area. However, Mrs Buchanan coordinates this training and support for the staff. She has had training as a mental health 'lead'.

Question 2: What support is available for your children?

All children can receive emotional support from our 'ELSA' (Emotional, Literacy Support Assistant) who is Mrs Knights. All children are involved in 'Heart Smart' lessons that teach them how to deal with their feelings. All children are involved in 'Mindfulness' activities on a regular basis.

If you have any worries, please do not hesitate to contact the class teacher in the first instance to discuss.

Question 3: Do staff have good relationships?

The simple answer is 'yes' – we have many social events usually organised by Mrs Knights who is extremely good at this! We have after school walks, Zumba and recently a pottery painting evening.

I hope this answers the questions some of you were unsure about. We will continue to update you on our well-being work.
