Please DO NOT send the office emails if your child is ill, please call the dedicated "Absence" phone line, which is checked before registration is signed off, to notify when your child is not well. All issues regarding our new digital telephone line have now been rectified. We thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

If you cannot provide a date for your child's return, we require you to contact us every day until your child is better and returns to school. Safeguarding regulations state if a child is absence for more than a day and we have not received notification of this absence from the parent/carer, then the school MUST notify the authorities that the child is "Missing in Education".
