THINKING DAY - THURSDAY 22ND FEBRUARY

If your child is a member of the Girl Guides or Scouts (Rainbows, Brownies, Guides, Beavers, Cubs, Scouts) they can wear their uniforms to school if they wish on Thursday 22nd February for Thinking Day.

Every year, on February 22nd, the Scouting movement celebrates the birthday of Lord Baden-Powell (b.1857), and his wife, Olave (b.1889), who was the first Chief Girl Guide. This is known worldwide as Founders Day. It is a day for Scouts and Guides to renew their promises together and reflect on how the century old values of Scouting still resonate in the fast-changing modern world. Members of Girlguiding call this day Thinking Day.
