### **SWIMMING LESSON HEALTH & SAFETY REGULATIONS**

In adherence to Health and Safety Regulations:

- Boys MUST wear swimming trunks and not loose-legged swimming shorts
- Girls MUST wear a swimming costume
- All children MUST wear a swimming hat to secure hair that is **below chin length**.

All children will be getting changed in the Swimming Pool Changing Rooms and will require a large towel to dry with and an extra towel (small) to stand on in the changing room. Goggles may be worn (individual's choice) but are not supplied by school.

Please provide your child with their named swimming kit in a named waterproof bag eg plastic bag on the day of their lesson.

### **SUN HATS & SUN CREAM**

As the weather is eventually warming up, please place sun cream on your child in the morning before school and provide sun hats. Children must apply their own sun cream at school, so we suggest either providing them with a named sun stick or parents applying a day-protection sun cream to their children in the morning before school.
