# St Matthew's CE Primary School Analysis of Governor Parent Questionnaire (April 2017)

During the April 2017 parent consultation meetings, governors invited parents to complete a questionnaire about issues relating to their children's education, communication and behaviour to name just three. # Responses:

The responses presented here are from the parents of 126 children. (Where parents identified that they had children in more than one year group, the responses were duplicated into those year groups)

Total number of pupils at St Matthew's on the days of sampling: 194

The results represent feedback from parents of 65% of our pupil population, which is a very positive response rate.

Two parents did not provide 'year group' information for their pupils but their responses were consistently in the 'agree' and 'strongly agree' categories.

### Analysis:

# Strengths

- The high proportion of parents who believe their children feel safe at St Matthew's (with 60% 'strongly agreeing' with this statement)
- Over half of the parents of the 126 pupils 'strongly agree' that they would recommend St Matthew's to another parent
- In total, 7 statements generated responses that were above 90% 'agree' and 'strongly agree'

# Concerns

- The statements which generated the highest number of 'disagree' and 'strongly disagree' responses relate to two key issues:
  - Behaviour / behaviour management
  - Communication
